- Needle bar height

- Sewing head brush out including the removal of old grease on teeth of all gears

- Obstructions to proper stitch creation is checked, burrs, pressure foot damage, or needle plate damage
- Presser bar pressure is set to create the proper stitch

- Primary stitch functions are tested with multiple needle positions in at least five stitch tests
- The feed functions are also tested in several length settings and reverse functions

MISSOURI STAR QUILT COMPANY RETREAT

We hope you can join us for the Missouri Star Quilt Company Retreat sponsored by the Havasu Stitchers on May 10 through May 13, 2017. The trip details are listed below in case you missed them in previous issues of The Dangling Thread.

"Little ol' Hamilton, Missouri has become a quilter's paradise—some might even call it the "Disneyland of quilting. A dozen beautiful shops line the main street, enticing restaurants have come to town, and there's always something new to find!" Click on the "Visit Us" page of the Missouri Star Quilt Co.'s website and this is the first paragraph you'll read, and I think that the statement is very true. There are currently 13 shops at Missouri Star Quilt Co., and it really does feel like a Disneyland for quilters.

RETREAT HIGHLIGHTS:

- ◇ Retreat Date: May 10-May 13, 2017 (Wednesday-Saturday)
- ◇ Space available for 30 attendees
- ◇ Theme: Murder Mystery
- ◇ Retreat fee: \$350 which includes:
 - * Lodging - 3 nights/4 days
 - * Meals provided as follows:
 - Wednesday—Dinner
 - Thursday & Friday—Continental Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
 - Saturday—Breakfast
 - * Trunk show with Jenny Doan on Wednesday evening
 - * Entertainment
 - * Bring your own UFO/project
 - * And of course...shopping!

We plan to arrive on Tuesday, May 9 and arrangements have been made to stay at the Retreat Center for the additional night, but here is the good news... Missouri Star Quilt Co. has agreed to include Tuesday night in the cost of the retreat. In other words... there will be no additional cost for our Tuesday night stay.

For the first 25 members who submit a 50% nonrefundable deposit (\$175...payable to Havasu Stitchers) and make the request, a Baby Lock Katherine sewing machine is available for \$10 and a sewing "kit" (cutting mat, rotary cutter, ruler, scissors, pins) is available for \$5, both for the entire retreat. Please note that the \$175 deposit is non-refundable but if you are unable to attend, the deposit is transferrable if you can find someone to take your place. The final payment of \$175 will be due to Havasu Stitchers by March 15, 2017.

If you choose to fly with the group from Lake Havasu, we will fly from Las Vegas to Kansas City, Missouri on Tuesday, May 9 and return on Saturday, May 13, 2017. Not all of our members are in Havasu full time but may still want to attend the retreat and of course, those members would need to arrange their own transportation. Southwest Airlines group rates are available but are still to be determined. More information will be provided after November 2, 2016 when schedules are out for May of next year. A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required at booking, with final payment due 45 days prior to the flight. Once final payment is made, seats are non-transferrable and non-refundable. In order to arrange a group rate, Havasu Stitchers Guild would need to submit both the deposit and final payment to the airline, and attendees would make payment to Havasu Stitchers.

Transportation to & from Havasu to Las Vegas is at your own discretion. Carpooling is an option, or consider taking a shuttle (van). Experience has been that the cost is approximately \$60 one-way per person.

Coach transportation from Kansas City International Airport to Hamilton, MO is available for approximately \$50-\$60 + tip round trip, per person, based on transporting 30 travelers. The fewer the travelers, the higher the rate would be (i.e., 20 travelers would be \$75-\$85 + tip round trip, per person).

Spaces are filling quickly, so if you're interested in attending please let us know as soon as possible and send your \$175 nonrefundable/transferrable deposit to Havasu Stitchers, P.O. Box 2875, Lake Havasu City, AZ 86405.

Please indicate:

- ◇ Whether or not you would like to bring your own machine/equipment or rent one of the Baby Lock machines & kits offered by Missouri Star Quilt Company.
- ◇ Whether or not you want to travel with the group or arrange your own transportation.
- ◇ Whether or not you would like to arrive at Missouri Star Quilt Co. on Tuesday, May 9, 2017.

Remember...your space is not held until we receive your \$175 non-refundable retreat deposit. Please note that any and all deposits or payments relating to the Missouri Star Quilt Company Retreat and trip should be made to Havasu Stitchers.
